

**What research funded by the U.S. Golf Association (USGA) has led to improvements in the grass species used for your home lawn?**

The USGA has supported research to develop new grass cultivars since 1921. USDA scientists, with financial support from the USGA, developed 'Tifway' bermudagrass used on home lawns in southern states, as well as seeded bermudagrass cultivars, such as 'Sahara' or 'Riviera'. Buffalograss development was supported by USGA research funding.
